The festival kicks off with Vida Verse: A Celebration of South Texas Poets on Tuesday, October 29 from 6:00 to 7:30PM. On Wednesday, October 30 from 6:30 to 8:00PM, the festival will host Un Cafecito with the Authors, a ticketed session featuring a book discussion over coffee and pastries. Families are encouraged to join in costume for the annual Trick-or-Treat Trail throughout the entire facility on Thursday, October 31 from 5:00 to 7:00PM, a fun and safe event for children and families.

Don't Miss Out On *The Civil Rights in the RGV* Exhibit


